Letter of Consent to Transfer and Use Biological Genetic Resources

1. Where the intended recipient of the biological genetic resources to be transferred (hereafter referred to as the “Requestor”) submits a Request for Transfer of Biological Genetic Resources (hereafter referred to as the “Request”), the biological genetic resources will be transferred to the said Requestor if the contents of the request are deemed suitable.
2. The Requestor shall enter into a Material Transfer Agreement (hereafter referred to as the “MTA”) in respect of the biological genetic resources for transfer with Shinshu University.
3. The Requestor shall pay a fee for providing the resources (the necessary expenses) as specified in the MTA.
4. The Requestor shall submit the duly completed Appendix: Acknowledgement of Receipt of Transferred Biological Genetic Material to the relevant person in charge promptly after receiving the transferred biological genetic resources (within 10 days, as a guideline).
5. The Requestor agrees without objection that he/she shall not permit the use by, nor shall he/she transfer or distribute to any third party, the transferred biological genetic resources, organisms derived therefrom, or substances or matter produced therewith.
6. The Requestor shall use the transferred biological genetic resources in accordance with the Purpose of Use and shall not use the biological genetic resources for any other purpose.
7. Where the Requestor presents the transferred biological genetic resources in or at exhibitions, conferences, papers or the like, he/she shall make the following acknowledgement: Insects were donated from Shinshu University according to a Grant-in Aid “National Bio Resource Project (NBRP, RR2002), Silkworm Genetic Resources” for Scientific Research from the Ministry of Education, Science, Sports and Culture of Japan.
