Drosophila (Sophophora) biauraria Bock & Wheeler, 1972

Diagnosis. Male, fore tarsomeres I and II each with longitudinal sex comb covering nearly entire length of tarsomere (the *montium* group); male abdominal sternite VI without setae; aedeagal complex (aedeagus fused with postgonites) with a pair of lateral expansions each apically bearing small claw in medial portion; medially notched protrusion of hypandrial median gonocoxite somewhat roundish at apices, with a pair of hypandrial setae; hypogynial, dorsal lobe small, triangular.
