
Drosophila (Sophophora) subauraria Kimura, 1983

Diagnosis. Male, fore tarsomeres I and II each with longitudinal sex comb covering nearly entire length of tarsomere (the *montium* group); aedeagal complex (aedeagus fused with postgonites) with a pair of small claws on lateral margins of medial portion; protrusion of hypandrial median gonocoxite large, M-shaped, with a pair of hypandrial setae; hypogynial, dorsal lobe medium in size, triangular; sclerite (perineal plate?) on dorsal surface of vaginal wall discoid, bilobed.
